

### Training Methodology

- ❖ Short-duration training programs aimed at employment generation/enterprise promotion.
- ❖ Use of latest technologies, tools and equipment for productivity and quality dimensions.
- ❖ Major thrust on hands on training for adequate practical training.
- ❖ Specially designed courses in respect of sponsored programs.
- ❖ Equal attention on modules like entrepreneurship, personality development, communication skills, health & hygiene, etc.
- ❖ Guest lectures by Bankers, DIC officials, Industry experts, etc.
- ❖ Periodic assessment and continuous guidance.
- ❖ Placement assistance through campus placement initiatives.
- ❖ Post training monitoring and guidance for wage/self employment.
- ❖ Training at rural doorsteps through setting up of extension training centres.

### Training through Extension

The training programs are offered also in extension mode through Rural Extension Training Centres spread across the State. Presently, the Institute has 40 such extension centres in nine districts viz. Adilabad, Nizamabad, Karimnagar, Medak, Warangal, Nalgonda, Mahabubnagar, Rangareddy, and Khammam.

### Admission Criteria

The trainees are admitted into the courses based on the required qualifications and aptitude for learning. The Institute follows the reservation criteria as per the government norms. The applications are accepted round the year and preference is given to those who wish to take up either wage-employment or self-employment.

### Collaborative Initiatives

The Institute is actively collaborated with various state and central government organizations viz. Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India for DDU-GKY Programs, Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), New Delhi, Director General of Employment and Training (DGE&T), New Delhi for MES Courses, National Council of Rural Institutes (NCRI), Hyderabad, National Institute for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (NIMSME), Hyderabad, Employment Generation and Marketing Mission (EGMM), Hyderabad, Department of Youth Service, Hyderabad. etc.

### Hostel Accommodation

There are three hostels (one exclusive hostel for girls) in the campus, which can accommodate about 300 candidates at any point of time. The trainees who wish to stay in the hostel can avail the facility by paying the charges towards boarding & lodging.

### How to reach the Institute

The Institute is located at Jalalpur village of Bhoodan Pochampally Mandal, Nalgonda District, Telangana, which is 42 kms. away from Hyderabad Central Bus Station. RTC buses are available from Dilsukhnagar Bus Depot to Bhoodan Pochampally (Via Kothagudem stage located at 35 km milestone on Hyderabad-Vijayawada National Highway). The Institute works from 10.30 am to 5.00 pm on all working days.

### The Institute

Working under the aegis of Department of Rural Development, Government of Telangana, Swamy Ramananda Tirtha Rural Institute (SRTRI) has been working for rural empowerment and economic well being. The core mission is to promote employability and entrepreneurship among the unemployed rural youth and women by providing suitable skill training in market friendly, employment oriented trades, using latest and smaller technologies for improved quality dimensions. It was inaugurated in the year 1995 by the then Prime Minister of India Late Sri P.V.Narasimha Rao for pro-active rural development initiatives in the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh. The Institute's Campus is spread across a sprawling 100 acres with a state of the art infrastructure and buildings equipped with adequate laboratories, workshops, classrooms, computer facilities and latest teaching aids, and furnished hostels separately for boys and girls.

### Skill Training Programs

The Institute provides short-duration skill training programs, free of cost, in about 20 trades, which basically fall in sectors like Information Technology, Rural Engineering, Eletrical, Electronics, Solar Energy, Food Processing, Automobiles, Farm Machinery Mechanism, Garments and Fabric Designing, Entrepreneurship, Personality Development, etc. to rural unemployed youth and women.

## Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY)

The following courses are being offered under DDU-GKY, Govt. of India in the campus. All the courses are residential in nature and offered free of charge. The trainees are assessed by NCVT assessing body. Placements are provided to all those who complete the course successfully.
